Sir,--

The Department acknowledges the receipt of a petition requesting that the hamlet of Saskatchewan Beach be raised to the status of a summer resort village.

I am enclosing four notices which you will please post in the manner provided by section 13 of The Village Act. It will be necessary for you to fill in the date on or before which complaints against such organisation may be lodged with the Deputy Minister of Municipal Affairs, as we do not know the exact day on which you may place the notices within the hamlet. Kindly allow at least three full weeks in accordance with the requirements of The Village Act, a copy of which is mailed to you under separate cover.

I may say that the description of the area to be comprised in the proposed village was secured from the Surveys Branch of the Department of Highways.

Be good enough to complete and return to this Department the enclosed statutory declaration relative to the posting of the notices.


